### **Work Your Circles!**

All of us can at least do this – it's just talking with people you already know. This is easy but important. Once you know you are talking to a progressive do Steps 1, 2, and 3! Have this info ready when you are having conversations or follow-up and provide it. Print it, carry it, have multiple copies to distribute, have links on your phone, or provide via emails so they can easily access the links. Let's all commit to **Work Your Circles** and tell everyone you know to work theirs too. This could be a groundswell and it starts with each of us!

**Step 1:** Make sure you, friends, family, and neighbors are registered and that information is current.

**Step 2:** If not, register! Go here to get the form and instructions.

**Step 3:** VOTE! Get a firm commitment from everyone that they will vote. Look them in the eye and tell them you are counting on their vote. Make them promise. Get and keep their contact info to provide election info, polling place information, and reminder to vote. Make it easy for them, access the links with them. Push.
